Friday 22nd, May

Touristic drive (140 km) through the Styrian / Lower Austrian Limestone Alps

Morning Drive through Klostersal and Hoellental between Rax and Schneeberg to Kaiserbrunn – Visitation of one resource of the 1st Viennese High Springs Water Pipe
Lunchtime Lunch and welcome by the Major of Reichenau / Rax (a summer holiday town during the dual monarchy period) Mr. Hans Ledolter at Rothschild Castle
Afternoon Continuation of the journey through lovely countryside with a beautiful view over the Vienna Basin to the Krupp town Berndorf – sightseeing of the world unique style class rooms, return to Bad Vöslau
Evening Homely get-together at a Bad Vöslauer wine tavern called “Heurigen”

Saturday 23rd, May

Valuation drive (156 km) through the Pannonian Basin to the Neusiedler See (lake)

Morning Trip through the Vienna Basin, across the Leithagebirge up to Rust am See and along the Hungarian border as far as Bucklige Welt
Lunchtime Having lunch in a cider tavern, which is typical for this region, in Schwarzenbach, an ancient Celtic Colony.

Conditions of participation

The driver must be in possession of a valid driving license (in case of drivers change, this is also effective for the co-driver). All participating vehicles must be allowed for road traffic. The driver is liable for the legally allowed registration.

The definite classification will be done according to the received notifications. The registration number will be assigned in sequence of the year of construction.

Entry Fee

Driver and vehicle	€ 135,--
Co-driver and each further passenger	€ 100,--
Children from 5 up to 15 years	€ 50,--

Included in the entry fee are: road-book, sticker, registration number, entry badge, entrance fees, buffet dinner on arrival, lunch at Rothschild Castle, dinner at the Heurigen, lunch in the cider tavern and dinner on the ending arrangement. All drinks need to be paid personally.

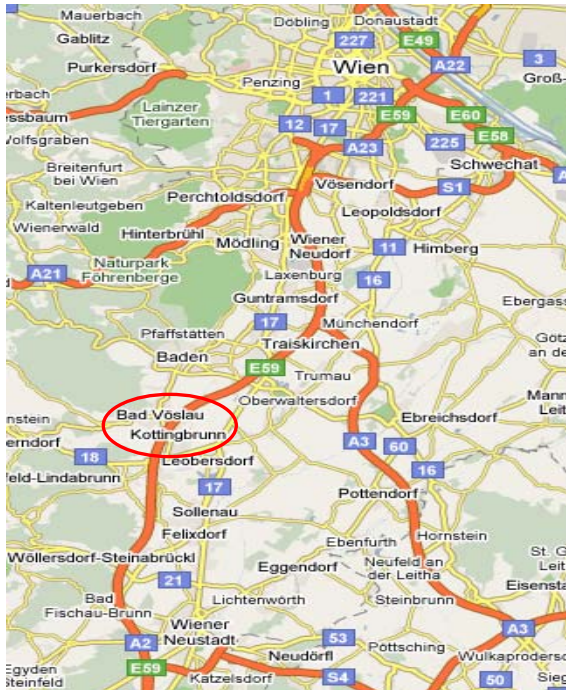

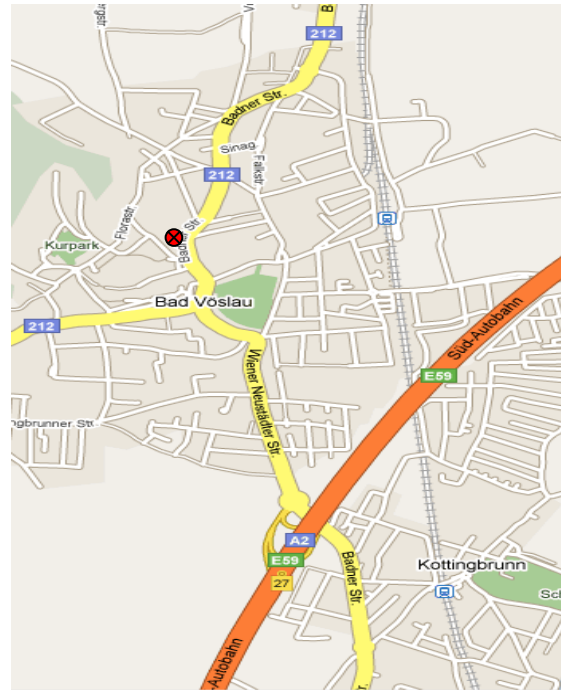

Liabilities (Common regulations)

Vehicles must be in a widely original, technically good condition, as well as allowed for road traffic. The driver has to carry the instructed officially car documents. Foreign participants also have to carry a confirmation of the automobile third party insurance (Green Card).

The drivers drive on their own risk at all points and have to follow the instructions of the Austrian vehicle law as well as the Austrian road traffic regulations. Instructions of the authorities and the road supervising need to be followed.

The drivers bear the total responsibility referring to safety in operation and road of their vehicles and the liability according civil and penal law for all damages caused by them or their vehicles.

As per hand over of the application form the participant accepts the rules of the defined regulations and resigns reference to the ordinary courts for all cases and confirms the agreement of having the unlimited liability for all damages on property and individuals either caused by the participant himself, his companions or his vehicle. He also guarantees that he will indemnify the organizer in respect of legal proceedings and claims. The organizer reserves the right to change the route and the realisation without giving reasons. He is allowed to cancel the event, in this case the fee will be refunded. Act of nature beyond control discharges the organizer from the realisation of the event.
